Understanding Tuition and Fees

Saint Louis University students with full-time time status† will pay full-time tuition and fees while students with less than full-time time-status will pay part-time tuition and fees. Students enrolled in fall and spring courses are assessed tuition and fees associated with their primary college, school or degree-granting center, regardless of the course or courses taken. Students enrolled in summer courses are assessed tuition and fees associated with the college, school or degree-granting center of the course, regardless of their primary college, school or degree-granting center.

Students registered for courses at Saint Louis University remain financially obligated for a course unless and until they drop it by the prescribed deadlines for dropping and adding courses (<https://www.slu.edu/registrar/register/registration-dates.php>).
