

ART HISTORY, MINOR

Saint Louis University's minor in art history provides a general introduction to Western art history that complements a range of majors. The art history minor requires 18 hours of coursework, with nine hours from 3000- and 4000-level courses.

The art history minor is available on both the St. Louis and Madrid, Spain, campus.
