

MUSIC, MINOR

Students pursuing a minor in music at Saint Louis University must complete 22 music credits and participate in a performance ensemble for three semesters. The minor requires one credit of piano studies, 14 credits of music history and theory, three credits of music electives, and four credits of music lessons. Students are also required to attend a minimum number of recitals every semester.

The music minor is available on both the St. Louis, Missouri, and Madrid, Spain, campus.
