

MUSICAL THEATRE, MICRO-CREDENTIAL

The Musical Theatre Micro-credential consists of 11 required credit hours. Satisfactory completion of the required courses would allow the student to achieve beginning-to-intermediate knowledge and skill in the fundamental aspects of Musical Theatre performance: acting, singing, and dance.

Learning Outcomes

The student will demonstrate:

- The ability to critically analyze dramatic text and song lyrics/ composition for the purpose of performance;
- Beginning-to-moderate skills in vocal and physical character development;
- Beginning-to-moderate singing technique in Musical Theatre styles; and
- Beginning-to-moderate dance technique in Musical Theatre styles.
