

STUDIO ART, MINOR

Saint Louis University's 21-credit studio art minor is offered both at the Madrid, Spain, and St. Louis, Missouri, campuses.

The minor includes Foundational Experience in Drawing and 2D Design, plus a course in a three-dimensional medium: 3D Design, Ceramics I, Sculpture I or Fibers and Textiles. Studio art minors are also required to take an art history course, choosing from various cultural and historical topics. These four courses allow students to gain skills in observational drawing and visual organization in two and three dimensions and an understanding of aesthetics, theory and context for art-making.

Building on this, studio art minors take a further nine credits of studio art exploration courses. Students may work broadly, taking courses in multiple media at the introductory or intermediate level, or in-depth, taking a sequence of courses in one media.
